

# NSSCA

## By-Laws Article V-6: Honorary Membership

- a. The person who is nominated must have made a considerable contribution to guidance and counselling in the province of Nova Scotia.
- b. Candidates for honorary membership may be posed by any member of the association and such nomination must be received by NSSCA Executive prior to Sept. 15 of the year in which honorary membership is to be conferred. Honorary membership must have the recommendation of the NSSCA Executive.
- c. NSSCA Executive at its Sept. meeting will make selection from those names received. In the event no names are received, the Executive may use its discretion to select candidates for this honor.
- d. The number of honorary members should be no more than one per cent of the general membership as of November 1 of the previous year.
- e. Honorary members shall have all the privileges of active members except the right to vote at meetings and hold positions on NSSCA Executive.
- f. No annual dues shall be charged for honorary membership.
